

Telehandler Inspection Checks

Exterior

Wheels & Tyres

Check tyres are at correct pressure and free from excessive wear / defects. Wheel nuts and rim fixings secure. Wheel bearings in good condition, no leakage from hubs.

Fork Arm / Attachments

Undamaged, securely attached to carriage plate, decals and rated capacity clearly legible.

Carriage Plate / Quick Hitch

In good condition, not distorted, quick hitch and pins fitted correctly.

Telescopic Boom

No obvious damage / distortion; Warning decals clearly legible.

Hydraulics

Hydraulic hoses / pipes undamaged and free to track the boom; Pins, locks, hoses, cylinders and connections free from excessive wear, leaks and creep.

Stabilisers

Outriggers/stabilisers fully deployed and located centrally onto pads; in good condition and adequate to support the intended load. All locks in place and functioning

Machine Condition

No sign of cracked / unauthorised welding; All guards, cowlings and fasteners in place; No missing / loose nuts & bolts; Steps / handrail secure, undamaged & clean

Engine

Fluids

Engine, transmission & hydraulic oil levels topped up and free of leaks. Clutch & brake fluid reservoirs at required levels. Adequate water/coolant levels. Fuel tank full with no sign of leaks or damage. Top up if required (specify amounts on checklist).

Battery

Secure and free from corrosion, electrolyte levels topped up.

Filters

(Oil, Fuel, Air) Free from rust and sediment.

Hoses & Belts

Free from wear / cracks and delamination. Fan belt set to appropriate tension.

Radiator

Free from debris and with adequate water levels; No blockage / leaks.

Compartment

Free from trash / dirt build up. Access door locks securely. Check dipsticks and gauges.

Inside the Cab

Visibility

Horn, alarm/warning systems, camera, all lights & indicators clean and functioning properly. Windows, wipers, washers & mirrors clean and free from damage.

Seat

Adjustment working smoothly, secure mounting and seat belt free of damage or wear.

Instruments

Switches, monitors, levers & controls labelled and functioning - includes steering, parking/service brakes, hydraulics, electrical & mechanical systems (inc. LLMI / C).

Interior

Cab floor clear of debris/obstructions; Door lock effective & secure; ROPS/FOPS fitted securely and free of damage; Fire suppression & first aid equipment available/in date.

Decals & Paperwork

Load charts & rated capacity info clear & understood. Vehicle manual & log book accessible – with current report of Thorough Examination.

Only competent and authorised personnel may use this equipment.

Remove ignition key when not in use. Wear seat belt at all times.

Report any unusual noises/faults or concerns.

Though every care has been taken to ensure the accuracy of our checklists, it will remain subordinate to any UK legislation and reference should be made to any user manuals supplied for the equipment in question.
